SUMMARY OF EXPERIENCE

Lawrie joined CRA Ltd at Broken Hill as a mining engineer in 1975, where he worked in underground production, ventilation, rock mechanics and technical services. In 1980 he transferred to the open pit base metal operation of Woodlawn Mines.

At Woodlawn, Lawrie held several permanent and acting positions including production scheduling superintendent, shift superintendent and manager mining. His responsibilities included short and long term planning, slope stability, ore reserve estimation and production scheduling, cost estimation and analysis, evaluation of life-of-mine options, while he represented the mining department in industrial agreements and wage negotiations.

Lawrie joined James Askew Associates Pty Ltd as Senior Mining Engineer 1985, establishing with a colleague the Perth office of that firm. He was immediately involved in feasibility studies for new gold projects, tender documentation for mining contracts, technical reviews and valuations. After working on projects in Australia and West Africa, Lawrie was appointed Manager of the consultancy's Perth office and Director in 1988. With continued growth and an increasing level of international activity, the consultancy was renamed Australian Mining Consultants in 1994 and AMC Consultants Pty Ltd in 2003.

Lawrie has continued to conduct technical audits, reviews and due diligence, and valuations of projects in Australia, Europe, North America and Africa, and prepare independent public reports.
